

Which Law was abolished by Christ?

Lesson 5

Christ did not give a new moral code. He was not a second lawgiver like Moses. He was far greater, and his moral teachings stand on a far higher plane than those of Moses. He was not so much concerned with laying down detailed rules for the regulation of the moral life, as with enunciating eternal principles by which humanity should govern their actions.

Christ did not give a new moral code, but He also did not say that the moral teachings of the Old Testament were suspended. The ceremonial and ritualistic laws of the Old Testament are cancelled for Christian, but not the Ten Commandments.
